Kimal will implement and maintain an Environmental Management System through certification to ISO14001:2015 and continually strive to reduce our impact on the environment.

This policy includes a commitment to continual improvement and prevention of pollution to protect the environment. This is achieved by setting achievable objectives, as well as a commitment to meet or exceed relevant environmental legislation, regulations and other requirements.

## **We will:**

- Comply with the requirements set out within ISO14001:2015 and any accompanying standards as a minimum.
- Continually work to improve our Environmental Management System to enhance our environmental performance.
- Make efficient use of natural resources by conserving energy and water, where practical.
- Minimise the amount of waste produced and recycle where possible
- Keep transport/vehicle use to a minimum and regularly service vehicles to maintain their efficiency
- Look where possible to reduce the level of plastic contained in our products, or use alternative materials, less harmful to the environment through the life cycle of our products, without affecting the quality.
- Work with suppliers and encourage them to reduce their impact on the environment
- Work to reduce our packaging where practical
- Raise awareness, encourage participation and train employees in environmental matters

We will communicate this policy to all Kimal employees and ensure that they are given appropriate training to raise awareness of environmental issues.
